Dear Residents, Families, and Caregivers,

As a continued effort to keep you informed of any COVID-19 activity, please see updated information on our current numbers.

Number of cases	
0	ADMISSIONS: Residents admitted or readmitted who were previously hospitalized and treated for COVID-19
0	CONFIRMED: Residents with new laboratory positive COVID-19
0	SUSPECTED: Residents with new suspected COVID-19
0	TOTAL DEATHS: Residents who died in the facility or another location
0	COVID-19 DEATHS: Residents with suspected or laboratory positive COVID-19 who died in the facility or another location.

Since our last letter dated May 29, 2020, there have been **0** resident confirmed and **0** new staff positive reports. In addition, we have had **0** new clusters of respiratory conditions this week for residents and **0** new clusters of respiratory symptoms for staff this week.

We will be offering outdoor visitation starting on June 15th. To set up a visitation you will need to contact Dawnette Shobert (Activities Director) at 570-323-8781. There must be a signed attestation form for each individual that visits. At this time there is a **2-person** per resident limit to visitations. The visitation restrictions and regulations for visitation inside of the Skilled Nursing Facility have not changed, even though some of the counties have transitioned into yellow or green. All Skilled Nursing facilities remain red and will be one of the last businesses to open.

We thank you for your patience and understanding during this difficult time. We continue to provide routine activities for your loved one(s) to keep their spirits up. This week we got to enjoy a western day, a white out and had a wear your neon colors day. The residents were very excited to see the staff do some country line dancing.
