Dear friends and families,

The following is the COVID update for The Williamsport Home. This information is very fluid and could change at any moment. As always, we will keep you informed as new information is received.

We continue to stress the importance of vaccinations to curb the spread of COVID-19. They are a matter of safety as well as compliance with the federal government's plan to mandate vaccines for health care workers at Medicare and Medicaid facilities. Currently 100% of our residents and staff are vaccinated, although a few may have only received the 1st dose of a two-dose series. When these individuals are eligible, we will provide them with their 2nd dose. Booster shots are another measure we are using to prevent COVID outbreaks in our facility and currently all our eligible residents have received their booster shots.

Our visitation processes are being monitored and controlled based on CMS guidelines. As noted in last week's letter, the guidance for visitation in skilled nursing facilities changed. As such, we changed our visitation protocols and you no longer need to preschedule visits with your loved one. We do, however, need to continue to follow the visitation and infection control guidelines as forth by CMS. The visitation expectations for visitation were shared in last week's letter and are posted throughout the facility.

Finally, we continue to provide group activities and communal dining for our residents while our building is free of a COVID outbreak. However, because of the requirement that visitors not be around other residents and staff when in the facility, we respectfully ask that you not participate in these activities at present. To do so, would prevent us from adhering to these social distancing expectations.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation with our masking, screening and social distancing protocols for our facility.
