As a continued effort to keep you informed of any COVID-19 activity, please see updated information on our current numbers.

Number of cases	
0	ADMISSIONS: Residents admitted or readmitted who were previously hospitalized and treated for COVID-19
6	CONFIRMED: Residents with new laboratory positive COVID-19
0	SUSPECTED: Residents with new suspected COVID-19
6	COVID-19 DEATHS: Residents with suspected or laboratory positive COVID-19 who died in the facility or another location.

Since our last letter dated December 4, 2020, there is **6** new residents confirmed and **6** new staff confirmed positive for COVID-19.

We have been working with CVS pharmacy with the vaccination role out. Though this is still very new to us and many others, we are hopeful that we will get the vaccination by the end of this year or early next year. In preparation for this vaccination we are asking the responsible parties to ensure that our Business Office has a current copy of your loved one(s) insurance card both front and back. As more information becomes available on the vaccination we will ensure to keep everybody updated.

The Activities Department has done an excellent job in bringing the Holiday spirit to The Williamsport Home and the staff have done an excellent job decorating the hallways.
