Dear Residents, Families, and Caregivers,

As a continued effort to keep you informed of any COVID-19 activity, please see updated information on our current numbers.

Number of cases	
0	ADMISSIONS: Residents admitted or readmitted who were previously hospitalized and treated for COVID-19
0	CONFIRMED: Residents with new laboratory positive COVID-19
0	SUSPECTED: Residents with new suspected COVID-19
0	COVID-19 DEATHS: Residents with suspected or laboratory positive COVID-19 who died in the facility or another location.

Since our last letter dated June 26, 2020, there have been **0** resident confirmed and **0** new staff positive reports. In addition, we have had **0** new clusters of respiratory conditions this week for residents and **0** new clusters of respiratory symptoms for staff this week.

The facility began universal COVID-19 testing on June 29, 2020. The facility tested 22 residents and 62 staff members on June 29th. On June 30th the facility tested 16 residents and 64 staff members. On July 2, 2020 the facility received 22 resident and 59 staff test results from the June 29th testing. The test results from June 30th will begin coming back to the facility this afternoon, July 3, 2020. Of the 22 resident and 59 staff member test results, we have **0** positive results. On July 6th the facility will resume testing and will have a final testing day of July 7th.

As a reminder, based on our test results there may be some changes that will occur within the facility. If we receive positive results, we will be required to move those resident(s) to the red zone. The facility has worked with the Maintenance department with the implementation of our red zone, which is now prepared in the event that there is a positive test result.

My team and I would like to extend our most sincere gratitude for your continued support and patience with everything that we are trying to accomplish, we understand that this is not easy for you or your loved one. The Activities Department continues to do an excellent job with the incorporation of activities and getting the residents involved.
