Dear Residents, Families, and Caregivers,

As a continued effort to keep you informed of any COVID-19 activity, please see updated information on our current numbers.

Number of cases	
0	ADMISSIONS: Residents admitted or readmitted who were previously hospitalized and treated for COVID-19
10	CONFIRMED: Residents with new laboratory positive COVID-19
0	SUSPECTED: Residents with new suspected COVID-19
0	COVID-19 DEATHS: Residents with suspected or laboratory positive COVID-19 who died in the facility or another location.

Since our last letter dated September 5, 2020, there have been **10** resident confirmed and **1** new staff confirmed positive for COVID-19. In addition, we have had **0** new clusters of respiratory conditions this week for residents and **0** new clusters of respiratory symptoms for staff this week. The total number of resident confirmed is 10 and total number of staff is 11 confirmed positive for COVID-19.

The facility is working with the Geisinger Regional Response Health Collaboration Program (RRHCP), who was contracted by the Department of Health to assist with COVID-19 monitoring and management. Full protective equipment (N95, face shield, gloves, and gowns) are in place for all resident rooms at this time.

All staff members that have tested positive are under quarantine and all staff members are Asymptomatic. All residents that have tested positive are quarantined and are Asymptomatic.

All employees and residents were tested for COVID-19 again this week. There are still staff and resident tests that are pending. Families will be notified immediately if you loved one is confirmed positive for COVID-19. The facility will also continue to notify the resident/ responsible party of all new positive residents or employees as test results are received. Testing will be completed weekly until the facility is COVID-19 free. We thank you for your patience and understanding and want to reiterate that our resident's safety and well-being as well as Infection Prevention are our number 1 priority.
