Dear Residents, Families, and Caregivers,

As a continued effort to keep you informed of any COVID-19 activity, please see updated information on our current numbers.

Number of cases	
0	ADMISSIONS: Residents admitted or readmitted who were previously hospitalized and treated for COVID-19
0	CONFIRMED: Residents with new laboratory positive COVID-19
0	SUSPECTED: Residents with new suspected COVID-19
0	TOTAL DEATHS: Residents who died in the facility or another location
0	COVID-19 DEATHS: Residents with suspected or laboratory positive COVID-19 who died in the facility or another location.

Since our last letter dated June 4, 2020, there have been **0** resident confirmed and **0** new staff positive reports. In addition, we have had **0** new clusters of respiratory conditions this week for residents and **0** new clusters of respiratory symptoms for staff this week.

As a reminder, outdoor visitations start on June 15th. To set up a visitation you will need to contact Dawnette Shobert (Activities Director) at 570-323-8781. There must be a signed attestation form for each individual that visits. At this time there is a **2-person** per resident limit to visitations. Any person that comes must abide by the following rules:

1. A mask must be worn during the entire visit. The mask needs to be placed as soon as the family member/visitor gets out of their personal vehicle.
2. The family member/visitor must pass the required screening prior to the start of the visit, which will be completed by the staff member assisting for the visit. If any family member/visitor fails the screening, they will be required to leave.
3. The family member/visitor is required to maintain a 6 feet distance from the resident at all times. At no point in time should the family member/visitor come closer than 6 feet away from the resident.
4. No touching in anyway is allowed from the family member/visitor.
5. No pets are allowed during visitation.

As a regulatory update, we are now mandated to do universal COVID-19 testing on all staff and all residents. This testing is required to be completed by July 24th. Once we have finalized our testing process, we will provide you more information. Our communication continues to be conducted via mailed letters, The Williamsport Home Facebook page and www.thewilliamsporthome.com.
