



Holiday Safety Tips

- Wear a face covering or mask at all times, except when eating or drinking. Please only remove your face covering or mask off when eating or drinking, and move as far away as possible from other people.
- Maintain physical distancing of at least six (6) feet apart from other guests at all times.
- Remind all guests to wash their hands often or use hand sanitizer often (before and after preparing, serving, and eating food; after handling objects; and after taking the trash out).
- Clean and disinfect commonly touched surfaces and any shared items in between uses.
- Practice infection prevention practices, including face coverings/masks, physical distancing, and hand hygiene, throughout the visit.
- Inform the facility staff upon return if people at the gathering were not staying six (6) feet away, not washing their hands, or not wearing face coverings (or masks).
- Please report to staff if someone at the celebration had COVID-19 or tested positive for COVID-19 after your visit for the next 14 days.
- The facility will work with you upon return regarding your risk exposure. The facility may recommend that you remain in your room for a number of days and will assist you in being tested for COVID-19.
- Request that everyone do their part to keep you and everyone in the facility safe.
